October 11, 2023

A regular meeting of the committee was convened at 1:33 pm on this date.

Matters listed below are hereby submitted with the following recommendations; to-wit:

1. Contract amendment for service between Special School District No. 1 and the Health Department for mental health services ([2023-00967](#))
  1. Authorizing an increase to contract COM4398 with Special School District No. 1, in the amount of \$3,000, for a new total amount not to exceed \$93,000, to provide mental health services to Henry, South, Southwest, and Washburn High Schools through Jun 30, 2024.
  2. Passage of Resolution approving appropriation of funds to the Health Department.

3. Community Commission on Police Oversight update ([2023-00966](#))

4. Targeted violence and terrorism prevention grant ([2023-00914](#))
